

Safety and Courtesy Expectations

Common courtesy and good judgement are expected from everyone in order that spectators, organizers, hosts, volunteers and fellow competitors alike have the maximum fun and enjoyment from the events. Sometimes a polite comment to a fellow participant may be in order to draw attention to an oversight that could be of potential concern to another person or group. Please respect your neighbour and remember the Golden Rule. Should you encounter difficult problems, do not hesitate to bring them to the attention of the show organizer or management. It is in everyone's interest that everything run smoothly for the maximum benefit of all.

1. Camping and parking on show grounds is a privilege,

whether or not a nominal fee is charged. Please treat your site respectfully, and remove all your manure, hay, bedding and trash before you depart.

2. Horses must be led with proper halters and lead ropes or driven/ridden with bridle and reins at all times.
3. Drivers and anyone handling horses **MUST** be a member of ADS or PSO's and have signed waivers because of insurance reasons.
4. Dogs are welcome at most events provided they are kept on a leash or in a kennel at all times. Not every horse is comfortable with an unknown canine, and please remember, this is an equestrian event.
