The Vancouver Island Chapter of BC Carriage Driving Society is the host of the Horse Crazy Adventures Field Trials and Combined Test. The FDT will consist of dressage, cones, and marathon with three obstacles in an enclosed area. The CT will consist of dressage and cones. These events are approved by BCCDS and sanctioned by Horse Council of BC. They will be governed in accordance with the HCBC Rule Book 2023. Knowledge of the rules is the responsibility of the competitor. Levels 1 (Training) & 2 (Preliminary) will be offered. ADS C (Training) and ADS C (Preliminary) dressage tests will be used. The FDT is a qualifier for the 2023 HCBC BC Driving Championship.

Arena size: **40m x 80m** for all divisions.

Pneumatic tires are allowed in Level 2 using solid spoked wheels. **No cantering in cones in Training level.**

General Rules:

Neither Vancouver Island Chapter of BCCDS, its board of directors, organizing committee, volunteers, officials or land owners will be responsible in any way, for damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses, or property of exhibitors, spectators, owners, drivers, trainers or grooms. All competitors must be current members of Horse Council of BC to participate at the Horse Crazy Adventures Driving Trials and Combined Test. Proof of membership must be sent with registration form.

Competition numbers assigned must be worn by the driver or be attached and visible on the carriage in the warm up area, in and around the exhibition grounds and during the competition. All competitors must wear properly fitted approved BSI or ASTM protective headgear with safety harness correctly secured at all times while driving on the exhibition grounds in the warm up area and during the competition. Under penalty of elimination, only the competing exhibitor may drive horses competing at the Horse Crazy Adventures Field Driving Trials and Combined Test from the time the horse arrives at the competition grounds to the end of the competition. Viewing the course is open Friday afternoon 3pm until 7.pm.

Unauthorized assistance of any kind during the Trials which includes any coaching, any signals or discussion given to the competitor by any individual who is not an Official, may result in elimination at the sole discretion of the Judges. Unauthorized passengers on the carriages are not permitted.

A hard copy of the HCBC Rule Book will be available to any competitor in the show office during the competition. The HCBC Rule Book is available for download online at: Horse Council of BC home page/competitions/competition documents. Or can be downloaded from the BCCDS Facebook page. The ADS dressage tests are available for download

Drivers will have a presentation/spares kit/safety check prior to each dressage test.

- *Turnout: Single, Pair, Tandem. • *Level 1 (Training) *Level 2 (Preliminary) • *Divisions: Horse, Pony, VSE. Divisions may be combined if there are few entries in the divisions..
- **Entry Fees: FDT.** BCCDS Members \$65 per day, 2 days \$115. Juniors \$40 per day, 2 days \$70. **Non- BCCDS Members** \$80 per day, 2 days \$140. Juniors \$55 per day, 2 days \$100
- **Entry Fees for CT. This is a separate event. Drivers can enter the FT and/or the CT Drivers will only complete one dressage test and cones course per day. Placings to third place in Training and Prelim level.** If entering both FT and CT, BCCDS member pays \$40 per day, \$70 two days. If entering CT only BCCDS Members \$45 per day, \$80 for two days. **Non- BCCDS Members** \$55 per day, 2 days \$100. Juniors \$30 per day, 2 days \$50
- **Dry camping no hookup, must bring your own temporary stalls**
- Dogs must be kept on a leash and contained in the camping/trailer area whilst the competition is in progress. Clean up after your dog.
- The cones course is Trot only at Training level. Prelim level may trot or canter in the cones course
- Canter is permitted only to make it up a hill: at the summit must come directly back to trot or penalties will occur.
- Worn protective vests are encouraged
- Drivers will have a presentation/spares kit check/safety check prior to each dressage test
- All turn outs must have a Spares Kit on the carriage
- 40x 80 dressage ring for all turn outs

2.8 (g) Vehicles

1. All vehicles must be in safe and good working condition.
2. Two or four wheeled vehicles are permitted
3. At Training Level pneumatic tires with wire spoked wheels are permitted
4. At Preliminary Level pneumatic tires with solid spoked wheels are permitted
5. Breeching may be used on single turnouts in Marathon if the vehicle is not equipped with brakes
6. Sulky or stirrup type racing carts will not be allowed.
7. All vehicles must have a solid floor

2.8 (a) Attire

1. Appropriate Driving attire is required for Dressage and Cones* (see note below) unless otherwise stated in the Prize List.
2. Marathon attire may be worn at all times* (see note below); however, for Dressage and Cones gloves are required for both driver and groom(s) Gloves are optional for Navigators / grooms for Marathon phase
3. Marathon attire consists of ankle length and durable pants, boots, gloves, a polo shirt, Tee shirt or fitted long sleeve shirt. Helmets are required.
4. Protective vests are encouraged
5. Shorts are not permitted
6. Inflatable vests are not considered safe for driving

Formal Dressage Attire is required if you are entering the Combined Test (CT).

Formal Dressage Attire:

Attire – as this is classed as a Pleasure Driving class formal attire is required i.e.,

Gentlemen – jacket, collar, tie. Apron or lap robe, brown gloves, helmet.

Ladies – dress, skirt, pant suit, pants, jacket, or long-sleeved blouse. Apron or lap robe, brown gloves, helmet.

Spares Kit:

Wheel wrench to fit axle nuts	Knife
Length of rawhide, string, or wire	Screwdriver
Leather punch rein splice or spare rein	Pliers
Trace splice or spare trace	Small hammer
Hame strap (if appropriate)	Hoof pick
Halter and lead shank per horse

RELEASE OF LIABILITY WAIVER OF CLAIMS ASSUMPTION OF RISKS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as the “Release Agreement”)

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

_____ **Initials** I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of BCCDS Vancouver Island Chapter. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless BCCDS Vancouver Island Chapter, officials, organizers, agents, volunteers, employees and their representatives.

_____ **Initials** I AGREE that by entering the Horse Crazy Adventures Combined Test & Field Driving Trials (the Event), I am subject to Constitution and Rules of BCCDS Vancouver Island Chapter, Horse Council of BC, the schedule, and local rules of the Event.

_____ **Initials** I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Event with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and this Event involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including but not limited to broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering or death (‘Harm’).

_____ **Initials** I AGREE to release BCCDS Vancouver Island Chapter and HCBC from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of BCCDS Vancouver Island Chapter and HCBC.

_____ **Initials** I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the BCCDS Vancouver Island Chapter, HCBC, officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, or any other affiliate organization or participant of the Event.

_____ **Initials** I AGREE to indemnify, that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by BCCDS Vancouver Island Chapter or at this Event and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to my horse, or me and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Horse Crazy Adventures Trials July 08 and 09, 2023

_____ **Initials** If I am a parent or guardian of a minor exhibitor, I consent to the child’s participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child’s behalf.
