The Start times for Saturday and Sunday are tentative Should our entry warrant watch for our schedule to start as much as an hour either way.

Pleasure Driving Classes will be held in the dressage arena.

1. Pleasure Driving - Working.
2. Pleasure Driving - Reinsmanship.
3. Pleasure Driving - Command Class.

Following classes make up the HCBC Driving Trial:

Training and Prelim no cross entry

4. Dressage Training will use ADS Training test #B {2020}
5. Dressage Prelim will use ADS Prelim test #B (2020)
6. Field Marathon course

The marathon: will be held in an adjacent area with uneven ground trees

The maximum distance is 3 km. With 4 obstacles including 3 gates for training, and maximum 3 km. with 4 gates for prelim.

7. Cones: The cones course will be held in the hay field with 14 gates for both levels.

AWARDS: Ribbons to 4th in each Class

Awards will follow the potluck on Saturday and once scoring is finished on Sunday

Each lesson is 45 minutes commencing on the hour.

EVENT INFORMATION

OPEN: singles or pairs / any driver regardless of age or gender

REFUND POLICY: A Doctor's or Veterinarian's certificate must be received by the Show Secretary no later than 48 hrs. after the close of the show. A 10% processing fee will be retained.

MEMBERSHIPS REQUIRED: Current Horse Council BC (or other Provincial Sport Organization) or ADS. A photocopy of your membership/license card **MUST** accompany your entry form or be received prior to the closing date. If membership has been applied for but you have not received your card, contact the organization and have them email or fax to you, confirmation that you have joined and send that along with your entry.

ACCOMMODATIONS: 70 Mile Motel: 250-456-7500

CAMPING: Free on site. Please park in designated areas only. Limited Electrical hook ups (@ \$25.00 per day available. There are out houses on site as well as water.

STABLING: We have only seven open air pens on site (\$15 a night) or you may provide your own portable pens/hotwire.

NO SAWDUST OR SHAVINGS ALLOWED ON SITE. Please clean up all manure, hay and garbage from your site. A manure disposal area will be provided.

Due to Covid please take all your garbage home

A cleaning deposit of \$50.00 Cdn on a separate cheque or \$50.00 at registration

The cheque or cash will be returned when you leave if your site is cleaned. It is your responsibility to get your sight inspected and your money returned Ken Huber will oversee inspection of sights

MEALS: Pub and Restaurant closed. 70 Mile General Store open during regular hours, we will have complimentary soup buns and salad on Friday and Potlucks Saturday and Sunday

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

This competition is a Horse Council B.C. Provincially Sanctioned Event and will be governed by HCBC rules. It is the competitor's responsibility to know the rules. The Horse Council Rule book can be found at the following link www.hcbc.ca/Competition-Documents.html **General Rules**

- 1. THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE** reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any activities, divisions, or classes; or advertised times; or officials if necessary; or to refuse any entry with reason. The Committee reserves the right to use its discretion in matters not specified in the rules, or to relax rules in cases of physical handicap.
- 2. GROOMS/NAVIGATORS** are mandatory for pairs in all competitions and for single hitches in Competition B. (exception single equines hitch under 120 cm). Minimum age for a groom is 14 years of age. Failure to comply will constitute disqualification of the competitor.
- 3. DRIVER/WHIPS** under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a (knowledgeable) groom(s) of 18 years and older capable of rendering assistance with equine knowledge in all phases and at all times when on the carriage.
- 4. THE SAME WHIP** must drive the same entry throughout the competition. However, in the case of illness, accident or physical handicap, the Judge has the discretion to allow a change of Whip.

5. **REMOVING THE BRIDLE** from an animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the grounds will result in disqualification. And you will be sent home with no refunds.
6. **SCHOOLING** may be done anywhere on the grounds and in the arena. The cones course, or obstacles may not be used for lessons. before Monday. They will be open on Monday. *Driving on irrigation lines is not allowed– you will replace the pipes you damaged = big bucks*
7. **BREECHING AND/OR BRAKES and Nose Bands** are required no exceptions.
8. **APPROVED HELMETS and VESTS are mandatory and must be worn by all Drivers, Grooms/Navigators and passengers throughout this Event and weekend.**
9. **HORSES MUST BE 4 YEARS OF AGE** or older in order to compete in the field driving trial and 3 for the pleasure driving classes. Proof of age may be asked for.
10. **ALL DOGS MUST BE EITHER CRATED OR ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES. NO DOGS ALLOWED WITHIN 50 Feet OF ALL FOOD SERVICE AREAS.**
- 11 **A COMPLETE SPARES KIT** is expected throughout the event but not mandatory
12. **IF SCHEDULING PERMITS**, competitors may compete with more than one entry at any level
13. **SHOW NUMBERS** must always be worn and visible on Saturday and Sunday when schooling, exercising and competing.
14. **CAMPFIRES ARE NOT PERMITTED** on the show grounds.
15. **GOLF CARTS, ATV'S, DIRT BIKES AND MOTORCYCLES** may not be driven on the grounds by anyone without a valid driver's license. Failure to comply will result in expulsion from the grounds.
16. The Field Driving Course and Cones course will be open to walk on Friday at 4:30 pm
17. Juniors may not drive a stallion.
18. To enter the Jackpot Series go on line to BCCDS website and register or you may enter on site prior to the commencement of the competition, forms will be available
19. **EQUINE SIZES AND SPEED FOR THIS COMPETITION ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

VSE: 99cm and under	9kph training	10K prelim
Small Pony: over 99 cm to 120 cm	11kph	
Medium Pony: over 120 cm to 137 cm	12kph	
Large Pony: over 137 cm to 148 cm	13kph	
Horse: over 148 cm	14k
