Tests: HCBC Level 1 B HCBC Level 2B ADS training "C" ADS Prelim "C"

Ring size is according to what you have available. Common sizes are 20x40m (vse), 30x60m, 40x80m. Work with what you have, letters can be on the fence, painted on milk jugs (fill with water) or on pilons. Tests will be emailed to you with your # after your entry is received.

Filming: Your camera person stands at "C" like a judge would (not anywhere else), I find in the back of a pickup works to get over the fence level etc. Practice filming a bit to get the hang of what you need and so they are comfortable with it. Film right from the entry at "A" to when you have completed your salute and are walking fwd to exit, do not stop recording throughout the test. Recordings are to be all one "go", no splicing in of better parts! Recordings are to be uploaded to YouTube and the link then submitted in via email no later than 8pm on August 15th. Please keep distractions around you when filming to a minimum (no talking etc.). As you enter the ring, have your "filmer" say "entry # _____, class # _____". Name your youtube video the same way, with entry # and class #. Do not use your name.

Basic rules for HCBC tests and for ADS tests available on their websites regarding tack etc. Please present like a horse show...i.e dressed nicely and clean! "Readers" are allowed for the HCBC 2B or ADS Prelim "C", but must stand at either "B" or "E" and can only read directly what is on the test – no adding in directions or "good jobs"! YOUR # MUST BE CLEARLY VISIBLE on the back and/or sides of cart/carriage.

You will receive your # when payment and entry form is received...remember you must have the # displayed when you film or your entry is invalid.

Ribbons handed out to 4th place. A high score ribbon for each test (regardless of equine size) will be also be awarded. Please enter HCBC level 1/ADS Training or HCBC level 2/ADS Prelim. Do not cross enter. Entry fee of \$15 per class
